- Don't Send Packages. This is a rule we have established through years of experience. We will hold any packages sent till after camp.
- Do Mail early! Send letters by Tuesday/Wednesday to arrive by Wednesday/Thursday. Your counselor will collect a letter prior to leaving for camp to hand out on Tuesday.
- Do Send self addressed stamped envelopes with your camper to make letter writing easy.
- Do Give camp address to other friends or family members, so they can send letters too!
